### **SUPPLY LIST**

- **Any of your favorite stamps and stencils**
- **Two sheets of teemplate plastic** (approx. 9"x12" each)
- **Freezer paper**
- **Scissors to cut freezer paper**
- **Newspaper** (a stack about an inch high)
- **Gloves** (Melody will provide a box of latex-free gloves for everyone to use, but if you have a favorite pair, please bring them)
- **Fabric:** Plan to bring 15-20 fat quarters (approx. 18" x 22" each), pre-washed (do not use fabric softener or additives), ironed and stacked flat (not folded). Please have all fabric cut to this size—you are not likely to use all of your fabric. Bring mostly light fabrics, some mediums and some darks. If possible, bring an assortment of the following fabrics: hand-dyed, batiks, tone-on-tones, solids (including white) and black and white prints (only those that have more white than black). Cottons, silks, sheers, blends and synthetic fabrics will all work. FYI, Melody will have white and hand-dyed fat quarters available for purchase at the workshop.
