Category Descriptions

- Traditional design but with computerized quilting on a long arm machine
- Traditional design but with hand guided quilting (e.g., hand quilted, free motion quilted by machine, etc.) and the method is declared in the quilt description in the above section
- Art/Innovative – Quilt illustrates independent, progressive techniques and designs with originality.
- Mixed techniques – Quilt uses two or more techniques (i.e., pieced, appliqué, embellished, embroidered, etc...).
- Themed - Quilt design and/or fabrics represents a theme (i.e., seasonal, children, holiday, etc...).
- Novice – Entrant may only enter in this category once. This is for their 1st, 2nd or 3rd quilt. Must be 18 yrs or older.
- Junior – Quilt is made by person under 18.
- Special Theme – Wearable Art and Accessories; Entrants in this category may participate in the fashion show on Friday night.
- LQG Workshop Project – Quilt started as part of a LQG Workshop/class.

Hanging of Large (Bed Size) Quilts (Please read below and choose your option on page 1.)

This year there are two options for hanging of bed size quilts, which can be quite long and the bottoms may drag on the floors.

1. Quilt will be hung from a 4" hanging sleeve (or hanging loops) attached to the top of the quilt by the quilt submitter. Quilt submitter will provide a sheet/other fabric to place on floor under quilt to keep quilt clean and minimize tripping. Note: Instructions for making a 4" hanging sleeve will be emailed to all entrants. Instructions will also be posted on the website.
2. Quilt will be hung using plastic clips so that it does not contact the floor. Particularly for longer quilts, a portion of the top or bottom of the quilt may not be visible as it will be folded over. A sleeve is not required if you select this method.

Show Regulations

- 1) Only Longmont Quilt Guild members can exhibit quilts in the show, with no more than 3 quilts exhibited per member.
- 2) Entries cannot have been exhibited in a previous LQG quilt show.
- 3) Separate entry forms for each quilted item are required. The entry forms must be received by Tuesday September 13, 2011. Completed entry forms are to be mailed to: Eileen Hayes 861 Neon Forest Circle, Longmont, CO 80504
 - A photo of the quilt must be included with Entry Form unless other arrangements have been made with Eileen Hayes or Dana Chapman. If you wish to have free pictures taken of your quilts, please bring them to the August or September 2011 Guild meetings. Photos may be sent by email. Photos become the property of the Guild and will not be returned.
- 4) Each quilt must be individually bagged in a cloth bag that is labeled with exhibitor's name and telephone number.
- 5) Each quilt must have a label affixed to the back of the quilt with the quilt name, exhibitor's name, address and phone number.
- 6) Quilt drop-off and pick-up dates and times will be enforced.
- 7) In order to make the process of awarding ribbons more equitable for all entrants, regardless of category, LQG reserves the right to award multiple ribbons where the number of entries in that category is disproportionately large relative to other categories.

Quilt Drop-off: Oct 11- LQG Meeting, *or* Oct 10, 11, 12, 9-3 at Donna Smith, 1113A Kimbark Street, Longmont, CO.

Quilt Pick-up Date/Time/Procedures: Saturday, October 15, 2011 from 5:30-6 pm at Boulder County Fairgrounds, Barn A

1. No quilt will leave the show prior to 5:30pm on Saturday October 15th.
2. A receipt must be presented in order to pick up each quilt.
3. Items must be picked up at the Fairgrounds between 5:30 and 6:00pm on Saturday, October 15th.
4. If you can't pick up your quilt(s), another person must have the receipts to pick them up for you on October 15th.
5. Quilts not picked up by 6:00pm on October 15th will be removed from the Fairgrounds location. Contact Eileen Hayes (303-772-7863; ephayes@comcast.net) to arrange for pick-up.
6. Only authorized personnel will be allowed into the Quilt Return Area while items are being prepared for pick-up.

I understand that insurance of this quilt, while in the possession of the Longmont Quilt Guild (LQG), is my own responsibility and that LQG is not responsible for loss, damage, or theft of the quilt. I also understand that I am responsible for the delivery and pick-up of my quilt before and after the show. If deemed appropriate, I agree that LQG can move my entry to another category. I give permission for my quilt to be photographed for LQG purposes (i.e., website display, show DVD, etc).

I have read the Longmont Quilt Guild Quilt Show regulations and agree to abide by them.

5. Each quilt must be individually bagged in a cloth bag that is labeled with exhibitor's name and telephone number.
6. Each quilt must have a label affixed to the back of the quilt with the quilt name, exhibitor's name, address and phone number.
