



## LQG JOURNAL QUILT CHALLENGE

Do it your way!!! Journal quilts give quilters an opportunity to try new techniques; celebrate life; honor people or events; work in a new way; create a sample for a larger work; be bold; be quiet; reflect on events and issues in one's life; explore doing a series on a chosen subject or style; use your stash; finish something; make a gift. Best of all, they are great way to keep yourself motivated as a fabric artist (AKA: quilter).

**Finished Size:** 8 (width) X 10 (height) inches

**Materials:**

- top, batting (or other material such as flannel, stiffener, etc.), backing
- material: cotton, silk, decorator fabrics, sheers, cheesecloth, etc
- edging: binding, satin stitched, rickrack, etc...
- embellishment: threads, yarns, found objects, buttons, beads, etc

**Style:** traditional, photo fabric, arty, quiet, wild, reflective, landscape, portrait, abstract, floral, stories, animals, series—anything goes

**Pocket:** Please place a 4" quilt pocket on the back for possible hanging.

**Label:** Please label your work on the back. Include the following: title, your full name, date finished, inspiration for the project, major materials and/or techniques used

**Most Importantly:** Bring your finished piece to share. We are planning to find a way to display these pieces in a group at the guild meetings.
